You have heard the African proverb, "It takes a whole village to raise a child." Our Homes of Love parents spend countless hours encouraging and praying for their children, trusting the Lord to produce good fruit in their lives. And you are a part of the village that comes alongside them, giving your prayers, encouragement, and financial support. One of our young men, Thai, shared this example of how your faithfulness and generosity are producing fruit!

"Recently, our new college mentor planned a day-long 'retreat' for us. We had so much fun as we sang, ate meals together, played games, and talked about hard issues and our response as Christians. We decided to name our group the Lighthouse, reminding us to be a guiding light in our city. We wanted our first project to be doing something special for someone at Christmas. We collected money, and I gave what I had saved from my part-time job as a tutor. There were a lot of great ideas, but we chose to serve dinner to homeless people in our city on Christmas evening. We all remember what it is like to be homeless. At the end of the day, our mentor told us she had a big surprise. It was REALLY big! We were each given a computer! I couldn't believe it!"

Thai has grown up in a home, experiencing the love of a family and learning about the love of Christ. He graduated from high school and is studying to be an engineer with a new college mentor to help him transition and a brand new computer. Thai and his friends are the Lighthouse, serving "the least of these" in their community. Because of you, stories like this are possible and the ripple effect will influence many, impacting eternity. Thank you for being a significant part of our children's lives. And we know there are more children waiting for their homes in Cambodia, Vietnam, and Zimbabwe. Thank you for helping provide a future for them too.

Homes of Love was established as an official non-governmental organization (NGO) in Cambodia. The in-country board met for their first official meeting in September 2015.

Home #11 opened in July 2015 with three new girls. A new College Coordinator was hired to mentor & support the growing number of post-secondary students in Vietnam.

ZIMBABWE

In April 2015, a pastor and his wife welcomed a 3-year-old girl, beginning Home #2. With the help of Homes of Love, Home #1 relocated after a major flood damaged their home.

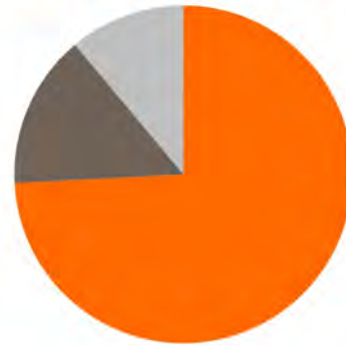
